School/Community: Carmel High School is accredited by the University of the State of New York. The comprehensive high school includes grades 9 through 12 with an enrollment of 1600 students and over 125 staff members. The Carmel community is a blend of rural and suburban areas located 55 miles north of New York City in Putnam County.

Courses of Study: Carmel High School offers a Local Diploma, a New York State Regents Diploma, Carmel High School Diploma of Excellence and an NYS Advanced Regents Diploma.

Graduation Requirements: Twenty-two credits are required for a Regents Diploma. Twenty-eight credits and three-hundred hours of approved service are required for the Carmel Diploma of Excellence. Students must pass the mandated state Regents examinations or Regents Competency Tests specific to the year of graduation in Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, and English.

Rank: To calculate class rank, the final average of each course, except Physical Education and Health, is multiplied as follows: Regents courses 1.0, Honors and College courses 1.10 and Advanced Placement courses 1.15. The products arrived at for each course taken by a student are then added together and divided by the number of quarter credits achieved by the student through freshman, sophomore and junior years. This quotient equals quality points and determines student rank. A student's exact rank and unweighted average appear on the transcript.

Extracurricular Activities: Students are encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities. The high school sponsors 49 interscholastic athletic teams, offered at the freshman, junior varsity and varsity levels, and 35 clubs and activities including vocal and instrumental music, annual musical production, Art Club, school newspaper, yearbook, literary magazine, Italian-American Club, Human Rights Club and Future Business Leaders of America, which has earned state and national recognition.

Special Programs: Carmel High School students participate in a variety of special programs including Peer Assistance Leadership, Students Assisting Students, Cooperative Work Experience and the Alternative High School.

Counseling Services: The Guidance and Counseling Department, staffed by six counselors, a psychologist, and a social worker, provides both day-to-day and long-term counseling, oversees student schedules and cumulative records, offers grade-by-grade parent/guardian meetings, administers standardized college tests and conducts an annual Financial Aid Workshop and College Panel.
